Discussion ensued, noting how special the little notes interspersed in each chapter captured the essence of how to learn about a student and build relationships with them. We all know how teachers can make a difference in a child's life but the book emphasised creating welcoming atmospheres, allowing students to "teach" teachers, empathising with and modeling for students, teaching confidence, character,a growth mindset, and grit. We had a joyful sidebar of the Latin roots of "self-efficacy", and agreed that this is a worthy virtue. While the book dealt mainly with elementary school scenarios, so much could also be applied to teenagers. Discussion followed, emphasising the importance and difficulty of building and maintaining these needed experiences and tools during the pandemic and virtual teaching.
- 2. Anna Christian reflected on ways to make connections now with students, when so many are virtual. She has weekly check-ins with her students where they share emojis to describe their moods. She mentioned that the poetic images and symbolism shared by poet Amanda Gorman during her reading at Biden's inauguration reignited her own passion from the mundanity of virtual teaching.
